



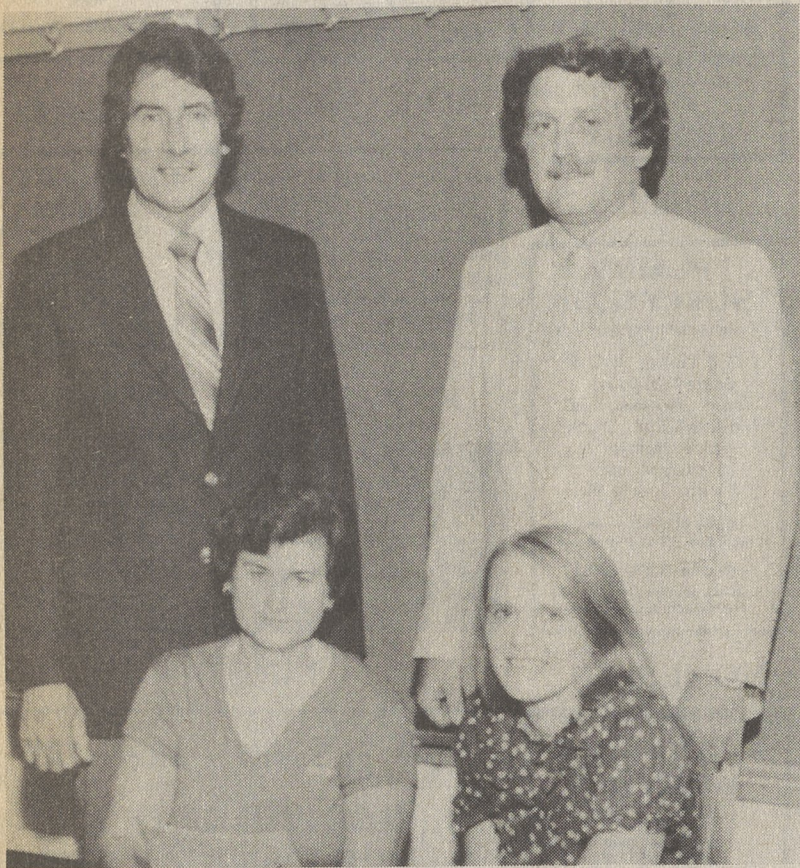
BPW party held
