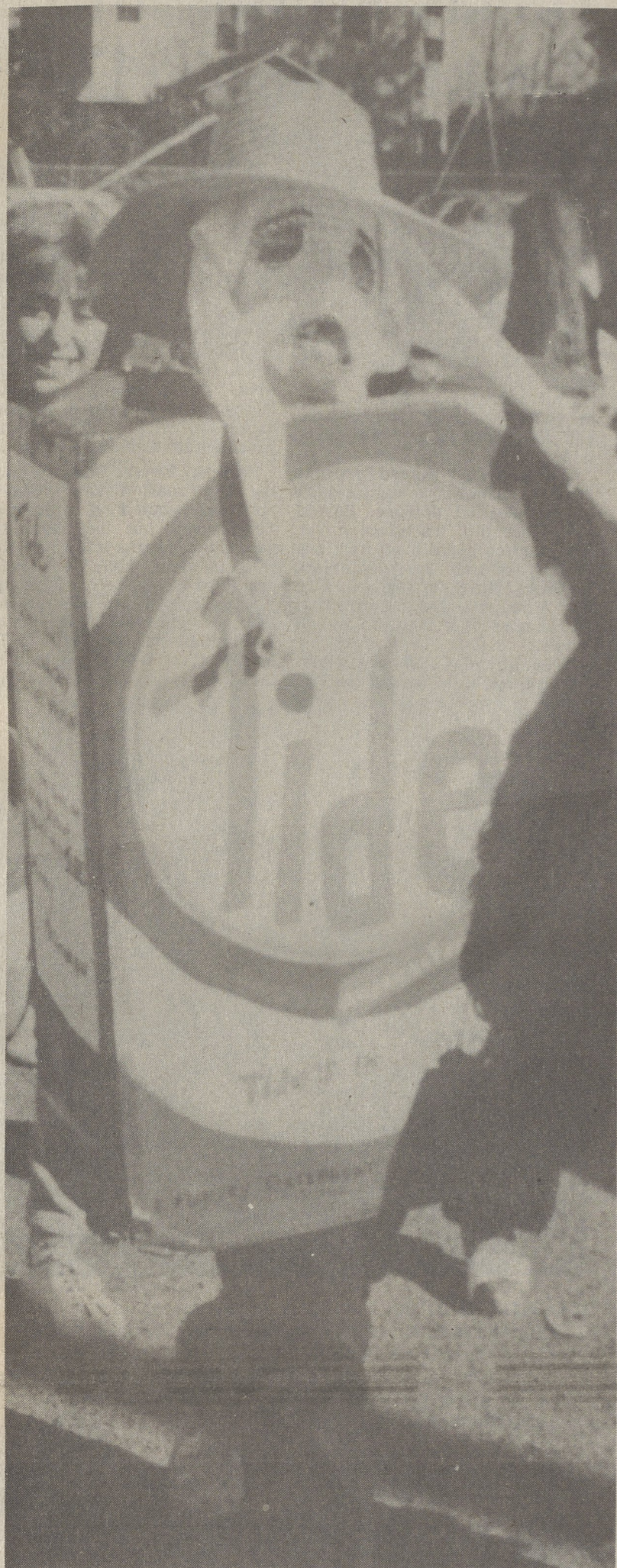


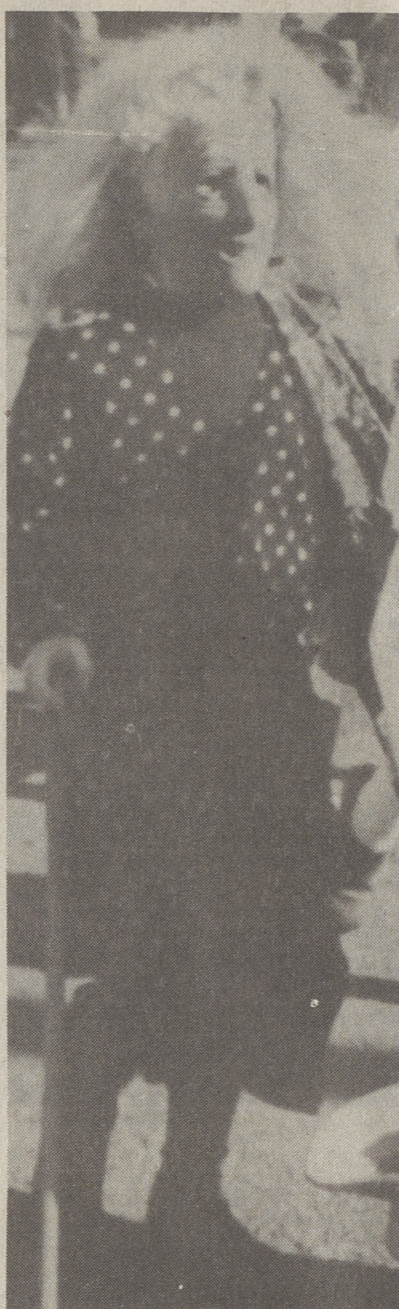

Walking Tide?

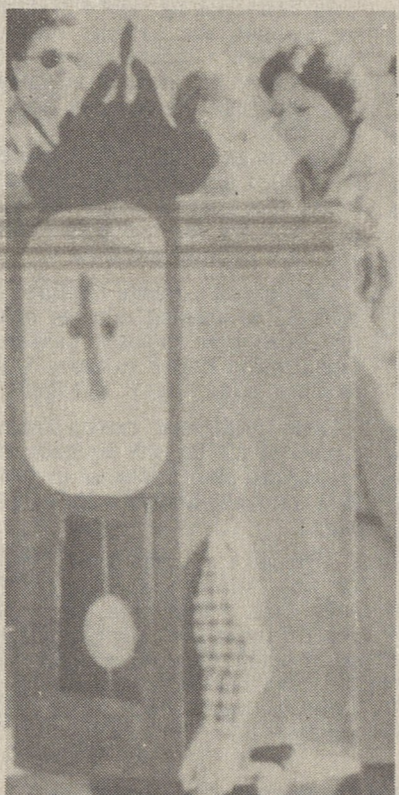
