"THE NEW LITERACY" is a three-credit telecourse which reflects the trend toward a more practical approach in introductory computer courses.

Luzerne County Community College will offer this telecourse during the Spring Semester, over WVIA-TV, Channel 44, on Sundays, from 7 to 8 a.m., beginning Jan. 29 through April 22.

The telecourse is an up-to-date survey of electronic data processing, computer hardware and software systems, and developments that will provide the basis for further advancements in information processing.

The course is designed to provide a comprehensive overview of the computer - what it is, what it can and cannot do, how it operates, and how it may be instructed to solve problems.
