by the committee's Planning Task Force. This information will be utilized in the preparation of a long-term marketing plan designed to identify specific industries and businesses that would most likely benefit from our area's strengths by locating in the valley.

The plan will also set forth a method of implementing a marketing strategy to reach and attract industries.

Frederick Hartwigsen is chairman of the planning task force, made up of over 400 volunteers working in 30 different

study groups to identify, compare and evaluate the valley's economic characteristics in terms of strengths and weaknesses.
