Billings graduates

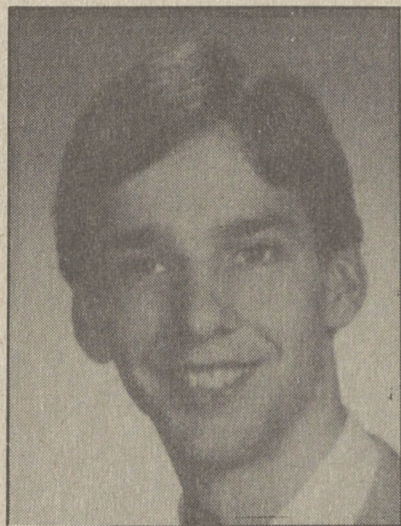

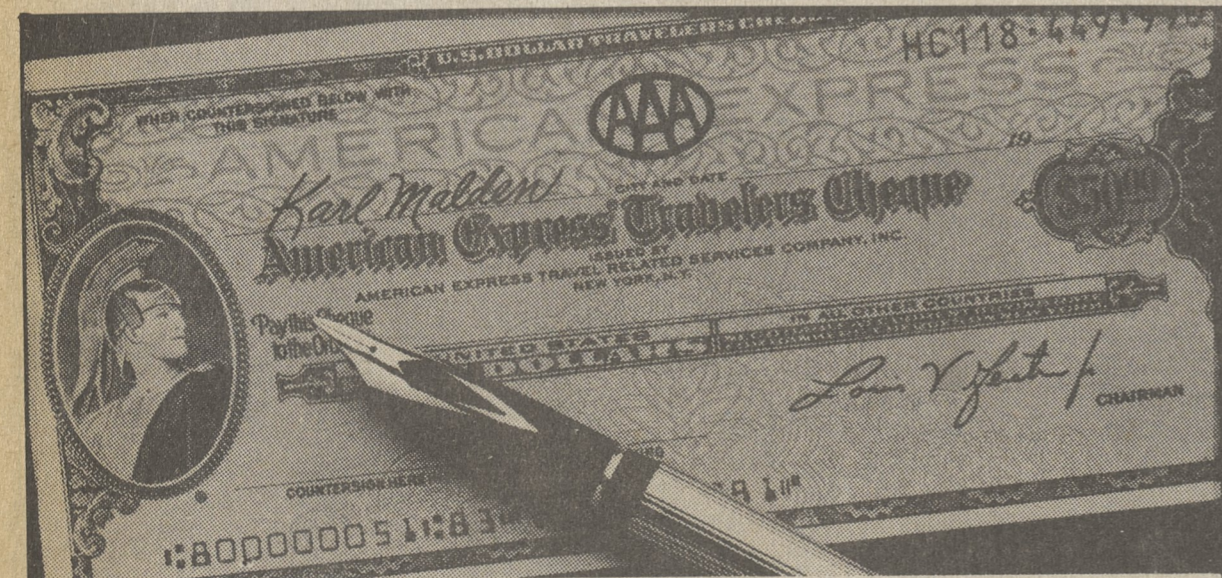
