NAVY PETTY OFFICER 2ND CLASS JAMES W. HADDLE III, son of James W. Haddle Jr. of RD 1, Dallas and Joyce Soska of RD 1, West Pittston, is a crewmember aboard the recently commissioned guided missile cruiser USS Yorktown, homeported in Norfolk, Va.

The ship was commissioned on the Fourth of July in its namesake city, Yorktown, Va. Approximately 8,000 people gathered for the Inde-

pendence Day ceremonies that officially welcomed the ship into active service.

The present Yorktown is the fifth U.S. Navy ship to bear the name. It is named for the historic Revolutionary War Battle fought at Yorktown, Va.

The ship is the second in the Navy's newest class of cruisers, equipped with the Aegis Weapon System, the most modern air

defense system in the world. The Yorktown is 567 feet long and has a crew of 360.


