## Dicton honored

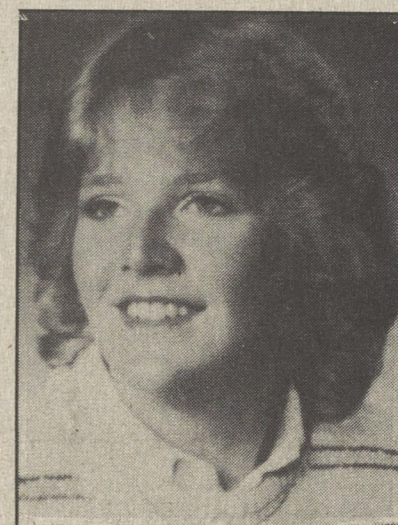
