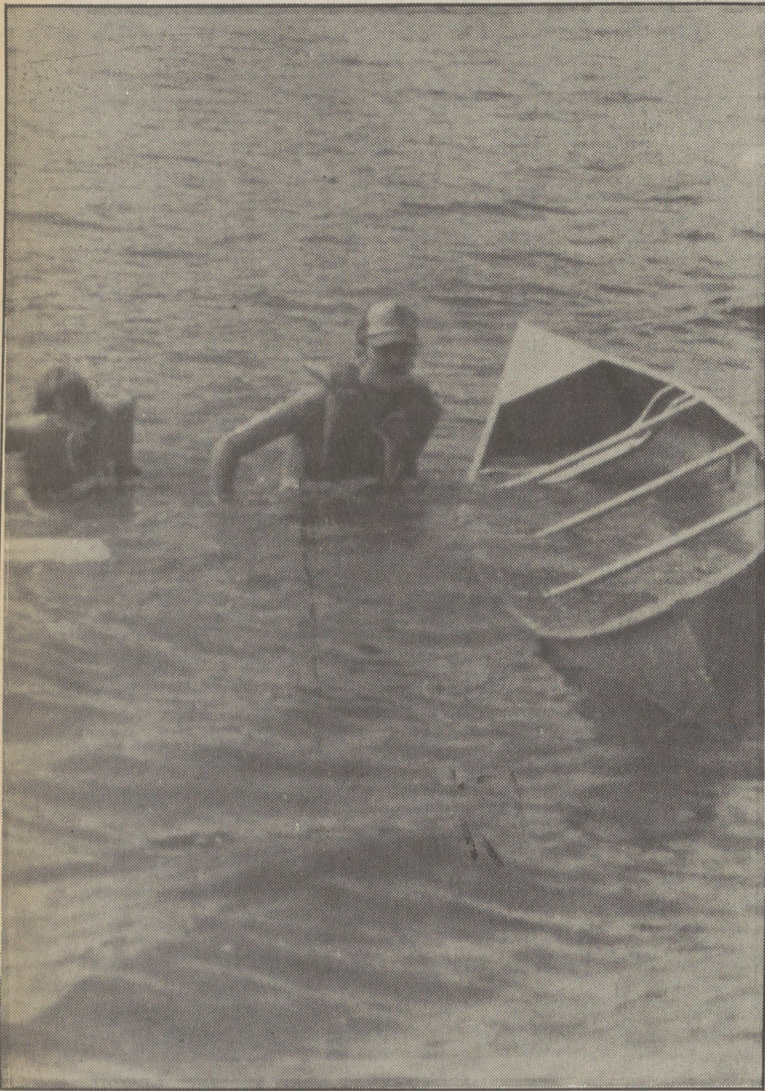


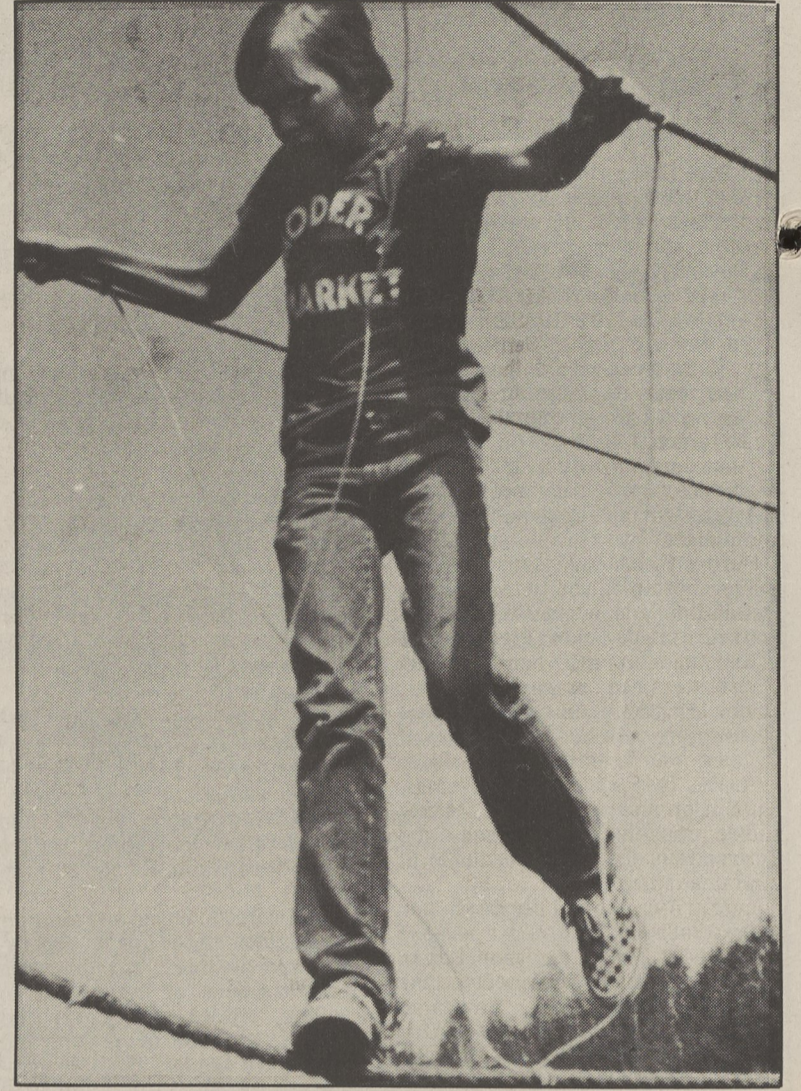

Kuras. Flower girls were Jodie Lane Urban and Jill Lynne Urban. Ring bearer was Jason Lee Stahl.

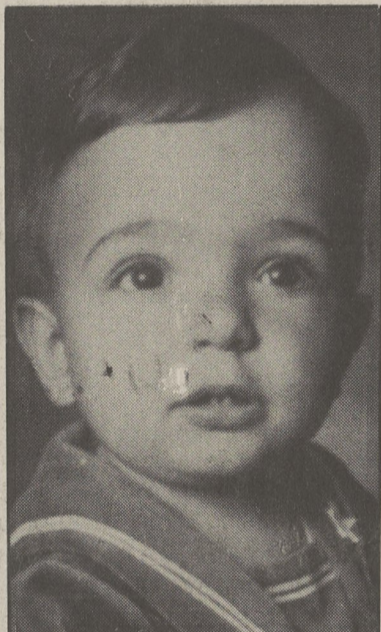
