Saab prices increase

Base prices for Saab automobiles will increase an average of 2.2 percent for 1985, according to Robert J. Sinclair, president of Saab-Scania of America, Inc., Saab importer. This is the first price increase on the Swedish-made cars since October 1, 1983, the Saab president said.

Suggested list prices range from \$11,850 to \$18,620.

In addition to the hike in the base price, additional standard equipment features in certain models are reflected in some price changes.

On the lowest-priced Saab 900 air conditioning and gas filled shock absorbers have been added to the list of standard equipment. The Saab 900 threedoor hatchback for 1985 carries a sug-

gested list price of \$11,850, up from \$11,110 in 1984.

Prices for the up-scale Saab 900S are increased for the addition of a four-speaker audio system with automatic power antenna and cruise control. The 1985 price of a three-door Saab 900S is \$15,040.

The top-selling Saab Turbo gets a new more powerful turbocharged and intercooled engine for 1985, with doubled verhead camshafts, four valves per cyclinder and microprocessor controlled fuel injection. The 1985 price of \$18,150 for a three-door Saab Turbo, also reflects the addition of cruise control as standard equipment. The four-door Saab Turbo is priced at \$18,620.
