Seven members of the college's counseling, careers and placement, athletics and ACT 101 staff have joined together to develop a new concept of student assistance in the various aspects of campus life. The "A"ssistance Center is now centrally located to provide not only a multitude of support services to the

students, but also serves as a retreat area to study and relax.

The services offered include the ACT 101 program which helps qualified Pennsylvania residents overcome financial and educational difficulties. This service also addresses social and emotional needs of the participating students. The comprehensive Careers and Placement service guides students as well as Alumni in all facets leading up to employment, including communication skills, resume writ-

ing, interviews or application procedures for graduate school. The athprogram intercollegiate mens and womens' basketball, baseball and softball, field hockey, cross country and volleyball. Intramural sports are available to students, faculty and administration.

The counseling staff provides individual attention to the many needs of the students including psychological assessment, research, evalua-tion and referral services for personal, academic and social growth.


Attend conference
