SECTION 1 The Official Zoning Map of the Township of Kingston is hereby amended to change the below-described premises from an OS zone district to an R-3 district.

SECTION 2 The premises hereby changed from an OS district to an R-3 district are described more fully in Schedule "A", which is attached hereto, made a part hereof, and incorporated herein by specific reference made thereto.
