

# West Side, 88-45 Lehman boys swamp

Bill Bearde and T. Willy Cadwalader combined for 41 points to lead the Lake-Lehman boys basketball team to an 88-45 romp over West Side Tech last Tuesday night at the Titans court.

The Black Knights took a first half 50-17 lead over the Titans with Bearde tossing in 19 points and Cadwalader hitting 14 of his 16 in the first and second periods. They led the team to a 23-5 score at the end of the first period and spurred

them to a 27-12 second period.

Bearde put in nine goals from the playing court and went seven-for-eight from the free stripe while Cadwalader put seven shots through the nets from the field and went two-for-two from the charity stripe. Earl Weidner and Brian James joined in the Knights double figures scoring with each collecting 10 points.

James went for six-for-six from the foul line and hit for two two-

pointers from the field. Weidner tossed four through the nets from the field and went two-for-two from the free line.

The Titans were hampered by injuries and were without their leading scorer, Joe Fetchko. They played the Knights even in the third period, each team scoring 17 points but the Knights came back strong in the final period to outscore the Titans 21-11.

The Knights had a good night at the fou line dumping in 22 of 28.

Joe Podskoc led the Titans with 13 points followed by John Butchko with 11.

The Knights game with Hanover Area last Friday was postponed due to the weather.

The Grenadiers of GAR handed the Dallas Mountaineers their first loss of the second half last Tuesday when they turned on the heat in the first seven minutes of the final period to outscore Dallas 10-4 and break open a tight game that, to that point, appeared it would be a repeat of the first half contest.

The Mountaineers again ran into GAR's Bill Callahan who put in eight of his game high 18 points in

the fourth period to lead GAR to their 47-35 win. Callahan also led his team in rebounding with 12 off the boards while Dallas Mark Farrell, Division 2's third leading scorer, was held to only eight points.

Sophomore Greg Skrepenak played outstanding inside defense and offense for GAR and collected 15 points.

Dallas led for a short time in the

first period but GAR went ahead and never gave up the lead for the rest of the game. The Mountaineers rallied in the closing seconds of the first half and in the opening of the second half, scoring seven consecutive points, five at the end of the first half and the first two in the second to close to 21-19.

At 3:36 into the third period a Grenadier was hit with a technical and Farrell put in the free throw to cut GAR's lead to 25-24. The Mountaineers missed a chance to take the lead when Tim Moyer missed two throws from the free line.

Going into the final period, GAR was in front 31-28 and started their sheeting led by Callahan.

Coach Clarence Ozgo said his Mountaineers just couldn't hit the nets in the final period and were outmuscled on the inside by the 260 pound Skrepenak. The Mounts top front line scorer, Joe Darling, was held to only six points.

Point guard Steve Wilson led Dallas in scoring with 12 points, tossing in five through the nets from the playing field and hitting two-for-

two from the foul line.
