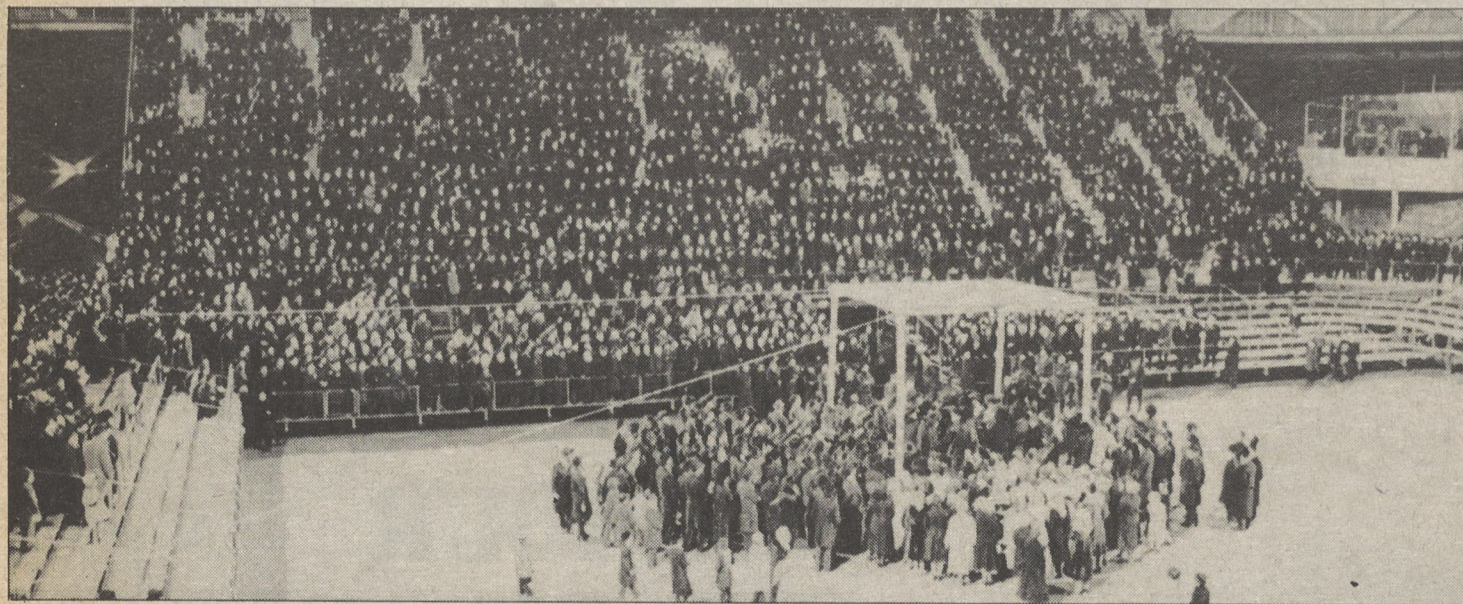
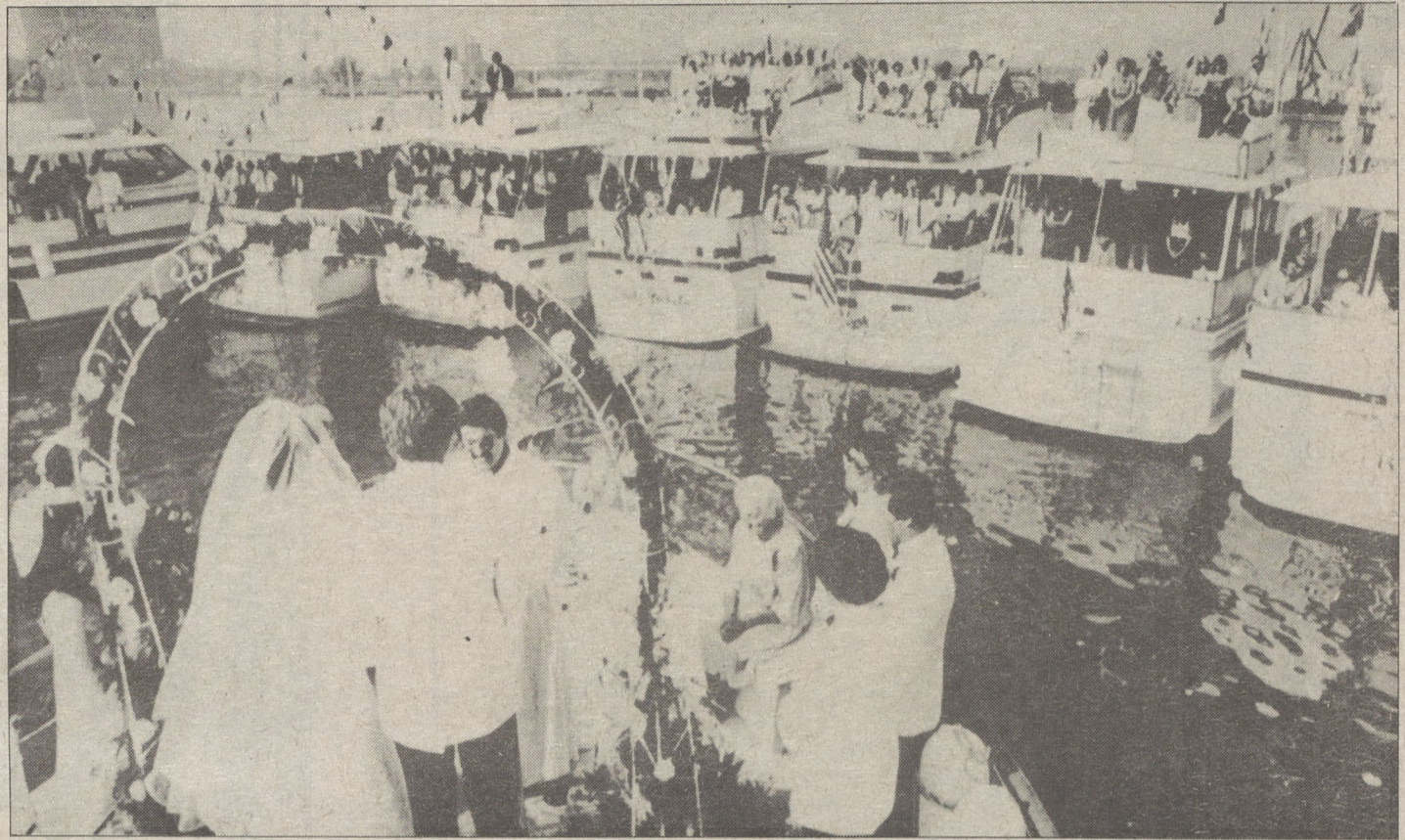
Unusual weddings back in style
