

Journey to 'The Brook' is well worth the trip

If you journey to "The Brook" Restaurant on Route 6 in Tunkhannock, try and schedule your trip at dusk; when twilight begins to obscure the tensions of a hectic life.

You'll find the highway of your approach slowly weaving itself into a lazy, winding road that takes you further and further away from the hustle and bustle of the city, into the beautifully mysterious domain of the Endless Mountains. They do, indeed, seem to continue on endlessly; rising out of the green-gray shadows into an orangeypink sunset, providing the sloping boundaries of what appears to be a colorful passageway into a magical frontier.
