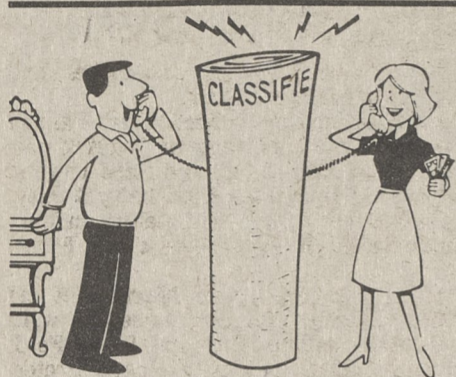
The program is especially recommended for business and industrial executives on all levels, union leaders, shop stewards and supervisors, social work professionals and concerned family members.
