The Luzerne County Crime Watch Association would like to bring to your attention OPERATION IDENTIFICATION.

Most burglars are opportunists. They don't care whose home they break into as long as they can gain entry fast; steal what they know they can sell and exit as fast as possible. Joining OPERATION I.D. may deter the burglar from entering your residence.

Borrow an electric engraver from your local Police Department. Most departments have the engraver to loan you free of charge. Engrave your valuables with "PA" followed by the Pennsylvania Operators Number which appears on your Drivers License.

If you do not have a Pennsylvania Operators License, you can use the number of a family member or close friend. They don't necessarily have to live in Pennsylvania.

OPERATION I.D. is an national program, therefore the operators number can be from anyone of the states.

Engrave this number on all your valuable possessions such as T.V., stereo, VCR's, etc. Engrave any portable item that might be stolen. A color photograph is recommended for items too small or too valuable to engrave. This is usually sufficient to prove ownership.

Chef and co-owner with his father, Allan Roberts Jr., prepares all entrees and specials, including fresh Spring Rack of Lamb, Sautee'd Veal Chops and Duck a L'Orange with finesse, flair and fresh herbs grown by his grandmother. Time-tested recipes with a distinct "Old World" flavor are the rule.
