If you do not have a Pennsylvania clsoe friend. They don't necessarily have to live in Pennsylvania.

**OPERATION I.D.** is an national program, therefore the operators number can be from anyone of the states.

Engrave this number on all your valuable possesions such as T.V., stereo, VCR's, etc. Engrave any portable item that might be stolen. A color photograph is recommended

for items too small or too valuable to engrave. This is usually sufficient to prove ownership.
