Management seminar conducted



Blood test may help

A simple blood test may some day predict which members of high-risk families will develop heart disease.

Family history has long been recognized as a major coronary risk factor, along with such conditions as high blood pressure, diabetes and high levels of cholesterol and other fatty substances in the blood. Until now, it has not been entirely clear whether a family's shared environment and diet account for the link or if relatives share some genetic defect that speeds up the accumulation of fatty plaque in the arteries—a condition known as atherosclerosis.
