A dinner at Hottle's is always a delicious one

For the diners who prefer beef, there is nothing more mouth-watering than the one pound T-Bone steak done exactly to order or Friday's special, top quality thick, juicy prime rib, which cannot be surpassed anywhere. Other entrees are so numerous, the most particular customer will have a difficult time deciding.

While waiting for dinner, don't fail to order from the bar. This is the time of year for Strawberry Daiquiri's and Hottle's is the place to enjoy the best.
