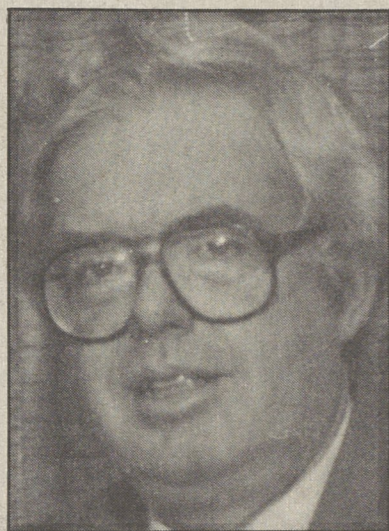
He resides at Harveys Lake, with his wife, Betty.
