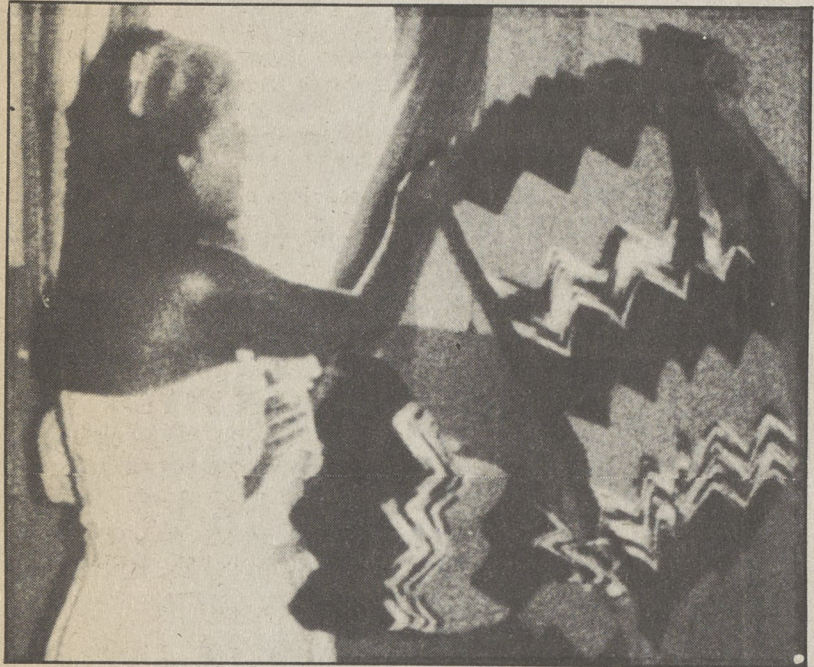

Wall named manager

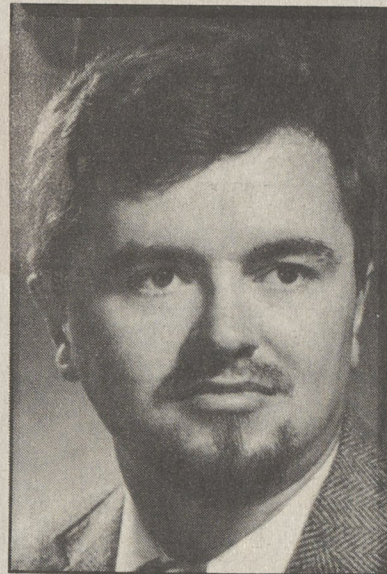
