Bill introduced

The state lottery's use of foreignmade hand calculators and coffee mugs as prizes has prompted the prime sponsor of legislation requiring the use of domestic products to step up his lobbying efforts for passage of the bill.

State Rep. Stanley J. Jarolin, D-Luzerne, said he introduced the measure (H.B. 775) last spring, but it has been stalled in the House State Government Committee.

"I intend to work House Bill 775 out of committee and out to the full House for a vote as soon as possible," added Jarolin. "I want it to be against the law for any state agency to use any foreign products, period. If it can't be gotten in Pennsylvania or the United States, it shouldn't be gotten at all.


