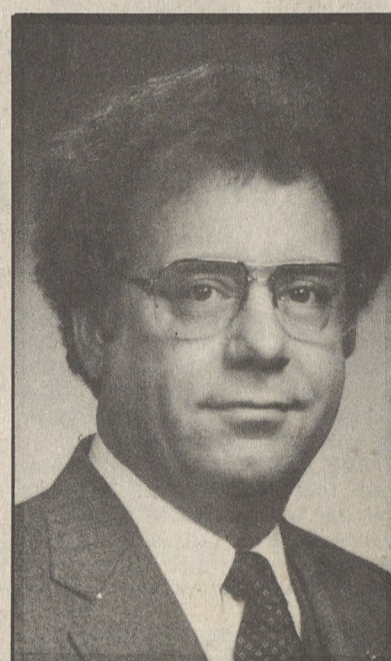
Kingston councilman to run for state office

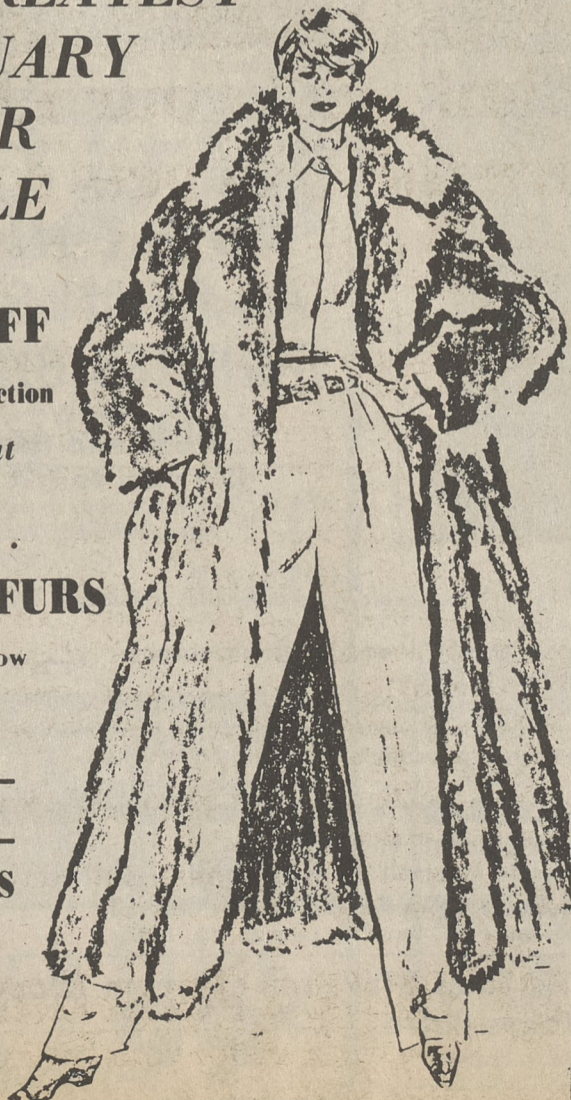

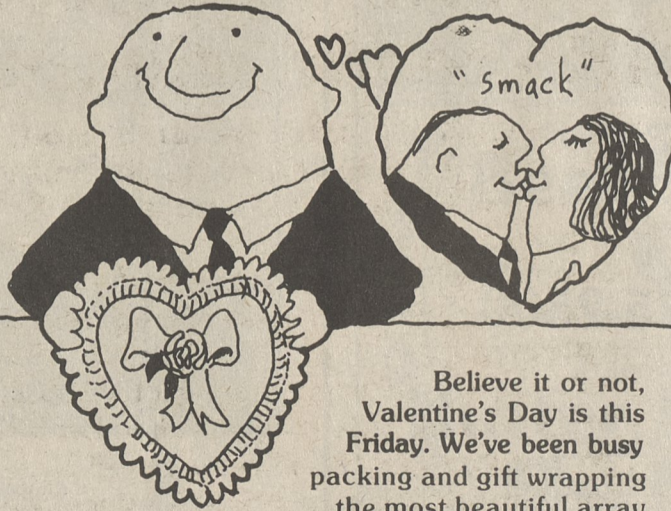
