The word "shall" is always mandatory and not hereby directory.

(a) "Borough" is the Borough of Dallas, Pennsylvania.

(b) "Borough Council" is the Governing Body of the Borough of Dallas, Pennsylvania.

(c) "Mayor" is the Chief Executive Officer of the Borough of Dallas, Pennsylvania.

(d) "Grantee" is Century Communications Corp., the Grantee of rights under this franchise.
