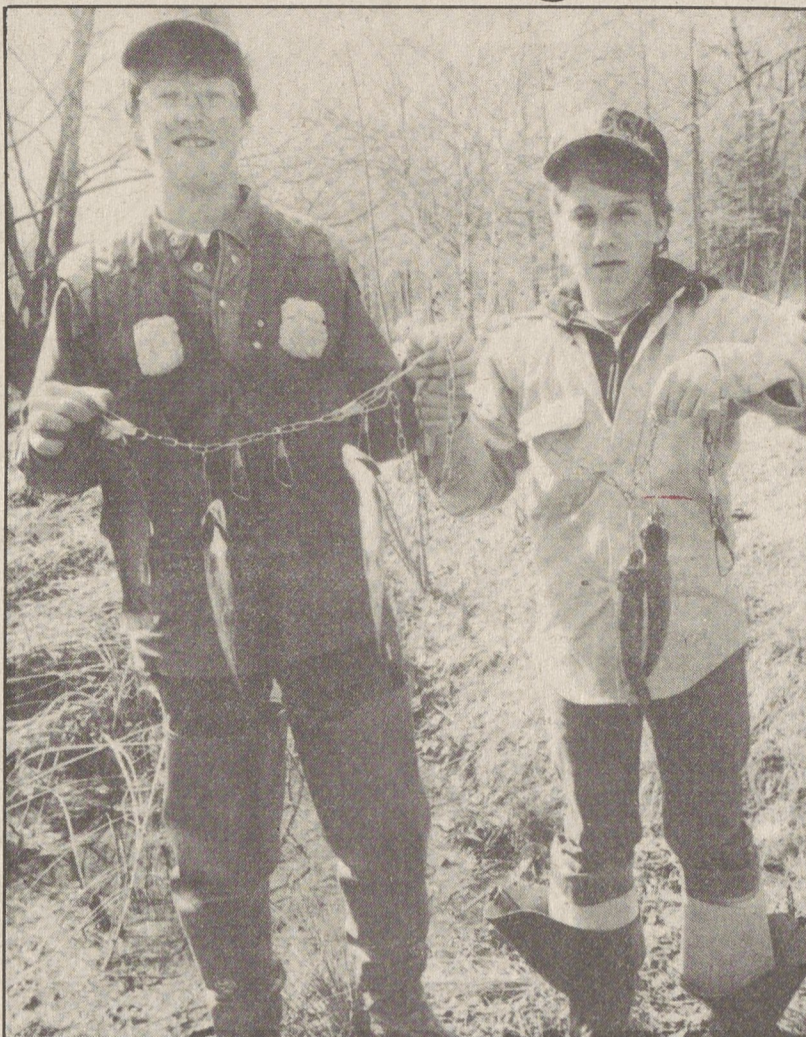


Opening day: Some caught, some didn't

Talk about being tickled pink? Just look at the grin on Sheryl Clark's face as she displays her catch of the day during opening day of the 1986 trout season.

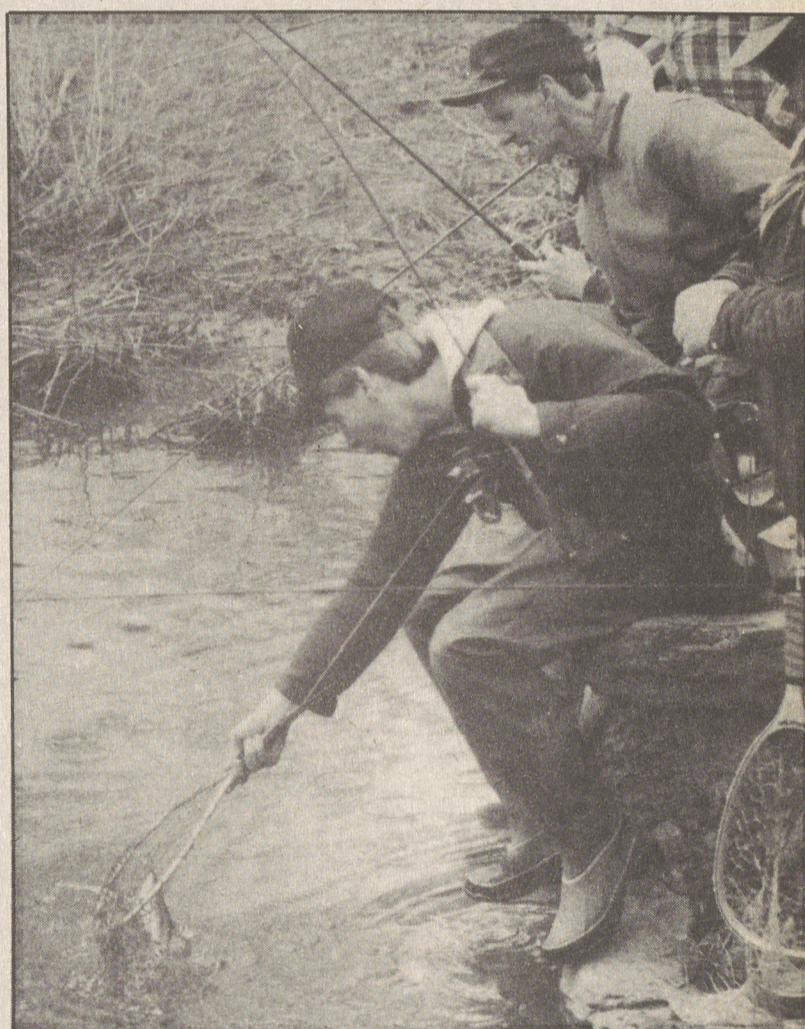

Couldn't be happier!

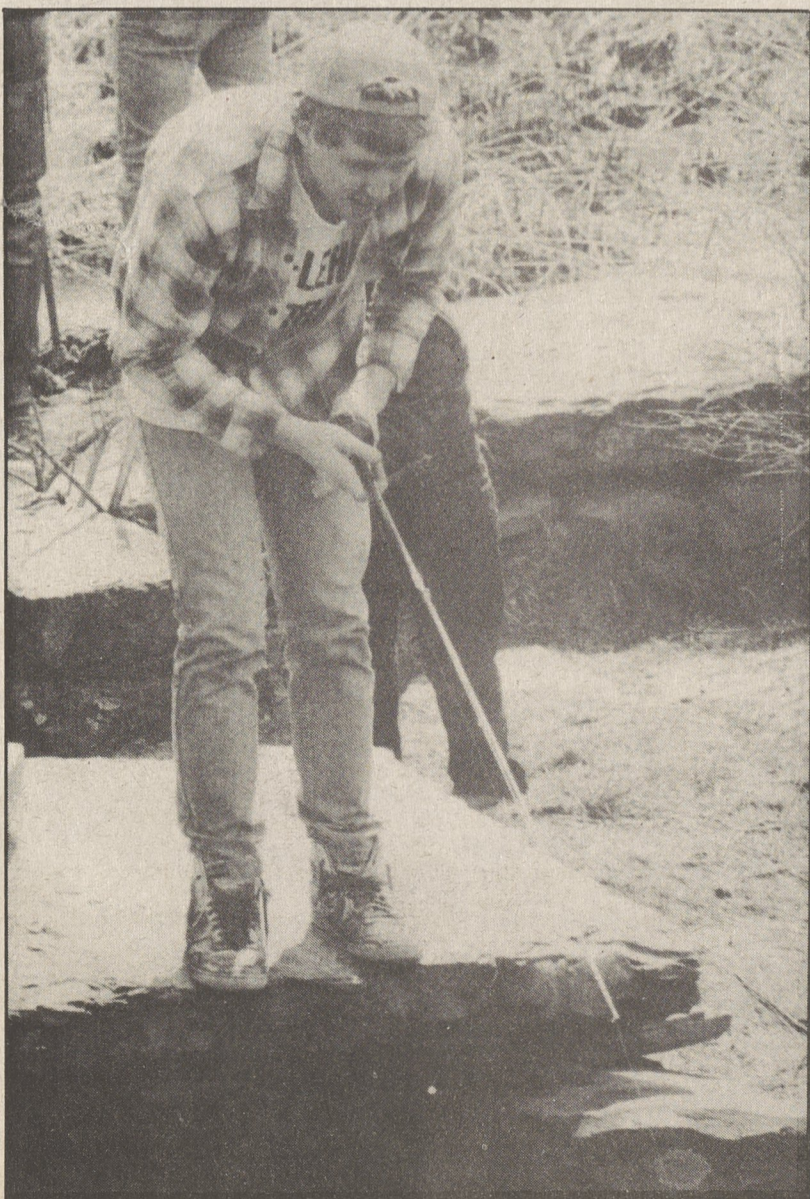
Don Shaffer, left, and Lynn Sheehan Sr., both of Dallas, couldn't have been happier on opening day of the 1986 trout

season this past Saturday. The two men were fishing at Lake Carey and both came home with a string of fish.



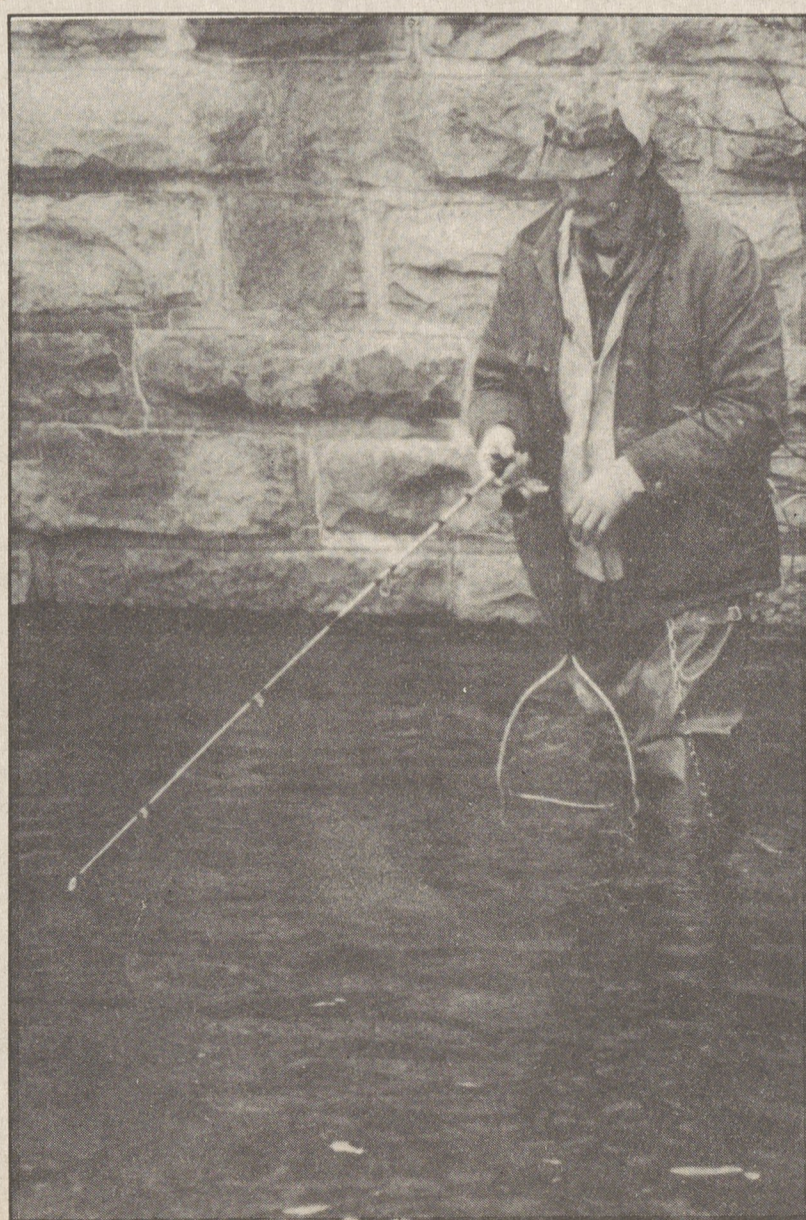
So close, yet...
