Scouts planning market

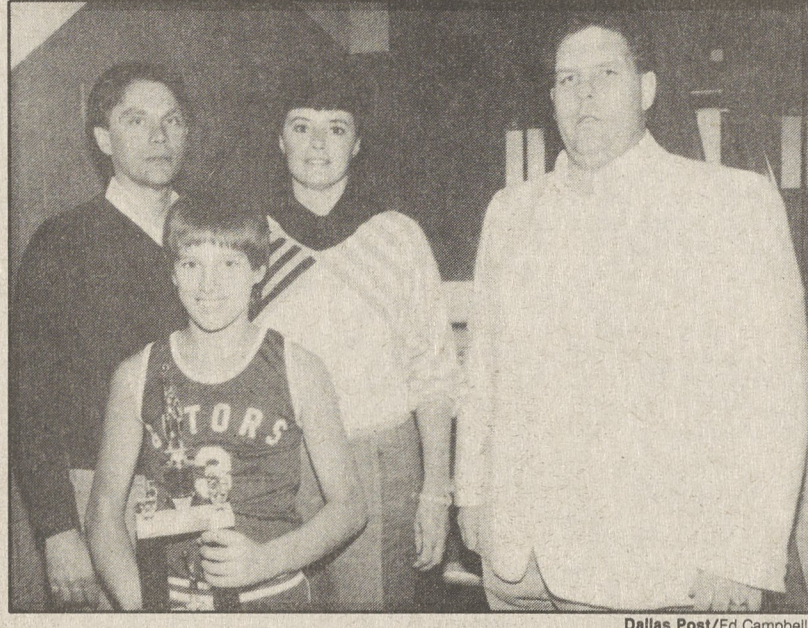

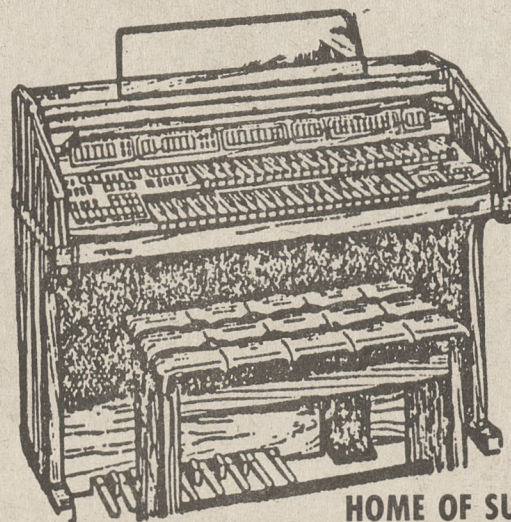
