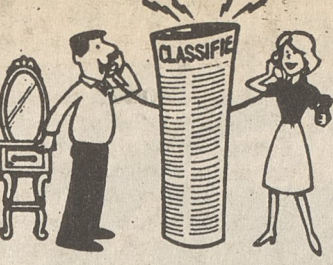

KINGSTON TOWNSHIP ORDINANCE 1986-3
AN ORDINANCE OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KINGSTON TO PROTECT THE PUBLIC PROPERTY AND TO PROVIDE PUBLIC SAFETY BY PROHIBITING THE FIRING OR DISCHARGE OF FIREARMS, SHOT-GUNS, AIR GUNS, AIR PISTOLS, SPRING GUNS, OR PISTOLS, RIFLES AND PISTOLS OF ANY CALIBER OR ANY IMPLEMENT WHICH IMPELS WITH A FORCE A PELLET OF ANY KIND, EXCEPT FOR LAWFUL PURPOSES, AND WITHIN CERTAIN DESIGNATED AREAS OF THE TOWNSHIP OF KINGSTON, AUTHORIZING THE SEIZURE AND CONFISCATION THEREOF AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR THE BREACH THEREOF.

Section 2. Discharging of Weapons Prohibited in Certain Zoning Districts.
Section 3. Discharging of Weapons Allowed in Certain Zoning Districts.
Section 4. Police Officers Authorized to Seize and Confiscate Weapons of Violators.
