**Want to relax? Try Rent-A-Tub**

Whether in mid-winter or in the heat of summer, Jim Johnson, owner of Air-Med Industries, has a new type of business in the Back Mountain that many residents may enjoy.

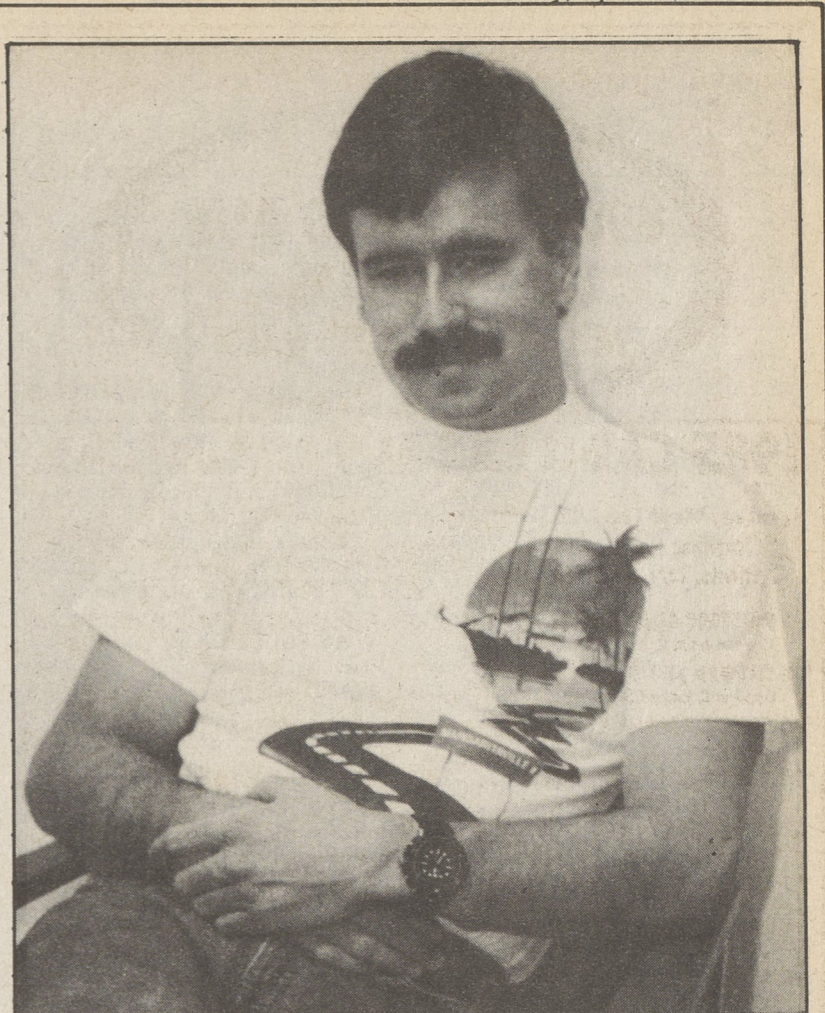
It is Rent-A-Tub -- not the use of a bathtub but a hot tub. No doubt many Back Mountain residents have heard of the hot tubs, quite popular in the New England States and other parts of the country, but, in most cases, they are sold and installed permanently either indoors or out-of-doors.

Rent-A-Tub is a more recent enterprise and an idea Jim Johnson got from New Jersey where a company did the same thing. According to Johnson, hot tubs are considered "spas" and come in all shapes, sizes and colors. Generally, they are a large tub filled with hot water at a temperature of 104 degrees, with high pressure water jets which can be controlled, installed around the inside.

The hot tubs are currently in use all of the large motels and hotels across the country and may be used inside or outside. In many cases, they are prescribed for the individual with circulatory or orthopedic problems.

Johnson has one installed in an enclosed porch of his home where it can be used all winter. He doesn't sell the tubs, but rents them for any length of time a customer might want one. The tubs are made of fiberglass, enclosed in redwood. Each tub is sterilized with alcohol and betadyne after being rented and returned by a customer.

Johnson said his company's major goal is to give an individual the opportunity to try the hot tub before making the invest-

ment in one which is costly. He sets them up and takes them down.

Originally from New Jersey, Johnson came to the Back Mountain area about five years ago when he accepted a position in the Emergency Medical Services Field. He is the director of the Emergency Medical Service Program at Luzerne County Community College and is also employed as a para-med at Nesbitt Memorial Hospital.

As mentioned above, Johnson owns Air-Med Industries, an air ambulance company which

transports persons by air to hospitals anywhere in the country as recommended by physicians to their patients. The company has three Lear jets at its disposal. Johnson is also a member of the Back Mountain Paramedic Unit and the West Side Mobile Intensive Care Unit.

His work and his business keeps him going almost around the clock. "Life is never boring," he said.
