Car crashes Ranchwagon

Charges are still pending against a 32-year old Shavertown man who crashed into the Ranchwagon Restaurant last week in Dallas Township. Police said that charges may be leveled against Donald W. Stritzinger, RD 7, Box 398, Shavertown, following the completion of the investigation. According to reports Stritzinger was traveling south on Route 309 last Saturday at 5:44 p.m. when he applied his brakes to avoid a collision with two vehicles that slowed down in front of him. His 1971 Plymouth, however, skidded across the north bound lane about 150 feet and into the building. He was taken to the Wilkes-Barre General Hospital where he was treated and released.

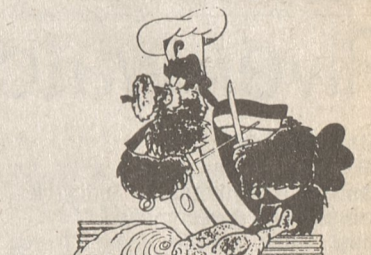
