Federally subsidized program

Free, reduced-rate meal policy unchanged

Dallas School District announces no change in the 1986-87 policy for the National School Lunch and or School Breakfast Program or the Special Milk Program for those children unable to pay the full price of meals or milk.

The chart to the left describes family size and income criteria as established by the Secretary of the United States Department of Agriculture determines eligibility.

Children from families whose income is at or below the levels shown below are eligible for free meals or milk or reduced-price meals.

Children of parents and guardians who are unemployed, or become unemployed, are eligible for free and reduced-price meals or for free milk during the period of unemployment, provided that the period of unemployment causes the family income to fall within the eligibility guidelines.

In certain cases foster children are also eligible for those benefits. If families have such children and wish to apply for free or reduced-price meals or milk, they should contact the school. They may do so by completing the application form sent home with a letter to parents. Additional copies are available from the school.

Applications may be submitted any time during the school year. The information provided on the application is used by officials to determine economic need based on the income and number of persons in the family. Applications that do not contain the following required information will not be processed:

1. the total household income must be listed by the amount received by each household member receiving income and the type of income it is (such as wages, child support, etc.) or your Food Stamp

all household members 21 years old or older or the word "NONE" for any household member who does not have a social security number, and

4. the signature of an adult household member.
If the household income increases or decreases by more than \$50 per month (\$600 per year) or when the household size changes, the school must be notified in order to determine a change in eligibility.

The information provided on the application is confidential and will be used only for the determining of eligibility. Neither the names nor the incomes will be released.

Deliberate misrepresentation of information may subject the applicant to prosecution under applicable state and federal criminal statutes.

The information on the application may be verified by the school or other officials at any time during the school year.

Children who receive free or reduced-price meal or free milk benefits are treated the same as children who pay for their meals or milk. In the operation of child nutrition programs, no child will be discriminated against because of race, sex, color, national origin, age or handicap. If you believe you have been discriminated against, write immediately to the Secretary of Agriculture, Washington, D.C. 20250.

Under the provisions of the school's policy, the school's approving official will review applications and determine eligibility. The name and phone number of our approving official are: Mrs. Rita Bren, 675-5201. If a parent is dissatisfied with the ruling of the local approving official, he or she may request a hearing to appeal the decision. Hearing procedures are outlined in the school's policy which is on file in the school's office and may be reviewed by any interested party. 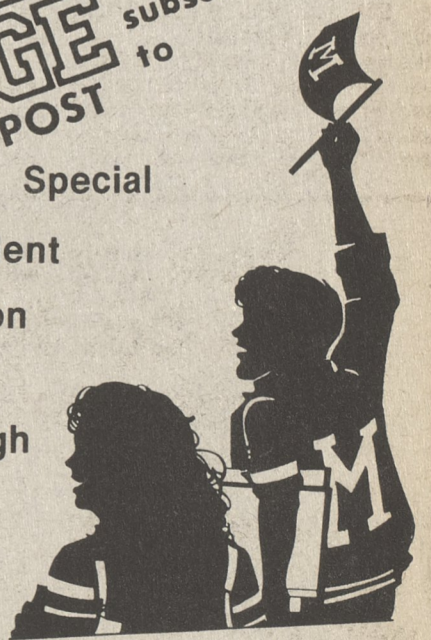
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
