### **H. SCOTT LEFKO**


H. Scott Lefko, formerly of Dallas, was recently named director of the new Chesapeake Job Corps Center, in Port Deposit, Maryland.






Barry C. Boyer, President and Chief Operating Officer of Merchants Bank North announced the promotion of Rosalie G. Strasser to Systems Officer.


Mrs. Strasser joined the bank in 1978 as a commercial loan clerk-teller and was assigned to the systems department in 1983.
