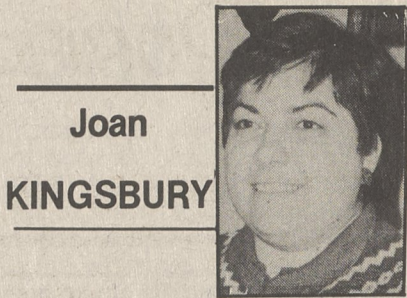


## Around town

## Library news

The Back Mountain Memorial Library is featuring in the display case hand-made wooden toys borrowed from Paul Davies of Lehman.

There are miniature gears in the cab, a spare tire under the trailer, doors that open in the back and all wood wheels on the truck. This 18 wheeler is the first wooden toy made by Paul and it is painted white with black tires and silver wheel covers. He has sold four or five of these trucks to truckers unfinished and the truckers have painted them to their own specifications.

Included in the display is a road roller and an engine with coal tender in natural wood. These toys are made from natural solid pine and are shaped with lathes, saws and sanders.

Paul has been making toys for about three years and takes orders for specific designs at his sporting goods store on the Lehman Outlet Road. He learned how to make these when he was out West from an

old toy maker, and what started as a hobby has turned into a business. He has some of the toys available at the store in the natural wood, a stained finish or painted with child proof colors.

These toys will be on display at the library until December 17th.

The Book Club met at the library for the November meeting with 13 members attending. After a short business meeting, an enjoyable program was presented by Nancy Sanders who gave some dramatic monologues and poetry readings. She began her career in Wales when she was three years old and studied drama at the Adler School of the Theatre in New York City.
