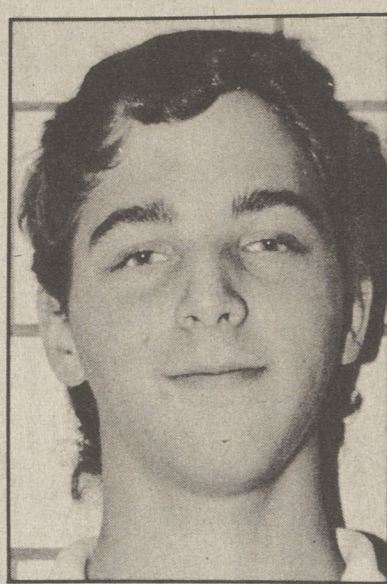


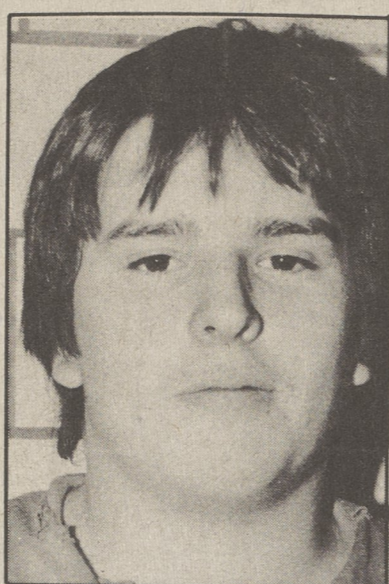

Seven Noxen wrestlers were winners in a recent Hughesville Tournament.

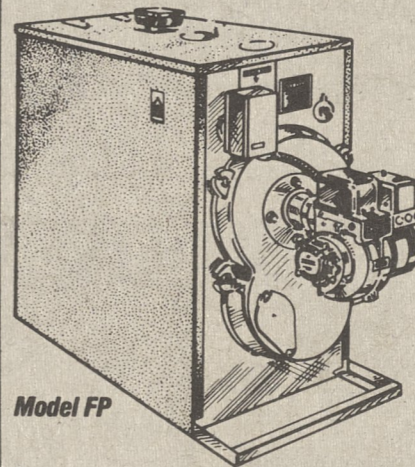
