Kingston Twp. honors its own

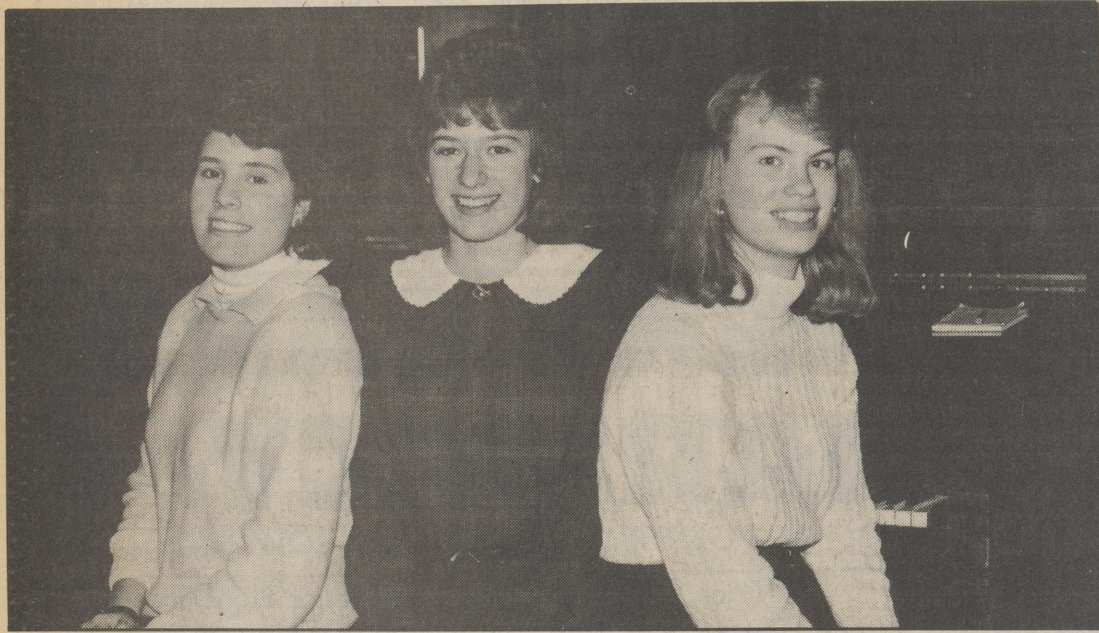
