Road repairs set

The Kingston Township Board of Supervisors have announced their schedule of public improvements for fiscal year 1988. Bids for the foregoing projects will be accepted by the Board of Supervisors in the very near future for road resurfacing and storm drainage projects totaling in excess of \$250,000.

Township Roads scheduled for resurfacing under contract include, Heights Drive, Oak Drive, Valley View Drive, Perrin Avenue, Longdale Avenue, and Warden Avenue. Roadways which are scheduled to be resurfaced by the Kingston Township Road Department include Armstrong Drive, Hartford Street, Timothy Avenue, Clover Lane, Cliffside Avenue and Church Road. In addition, storm drainage

projects will be undertaken on Highland Avenue, a portion of Perrin Avenue, N. Main Street near the Franklin Street intersection, E. Center Street at Wood Street, Valley View Drive, Cliffside Avenue, Warden Avenue, Timothy Avenue and Clover Lane.

Projects will be funded through appropriations made from the Township General Fund, State Liquid Fuels and Capital Improvements budgets. The Kingston Township Board of Supervisors also anticipate the receipt of a \$50,000 C.I.P. Grant from the Luzerne County Office of Community Development which will be used to fund projects in the low to moderate income areas of the township.

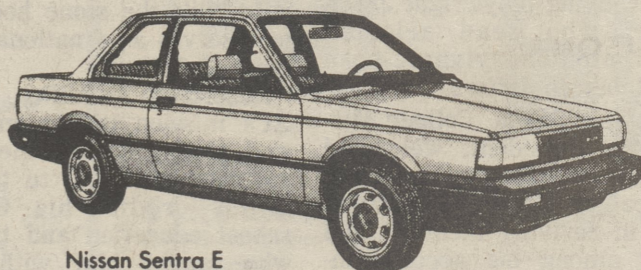
