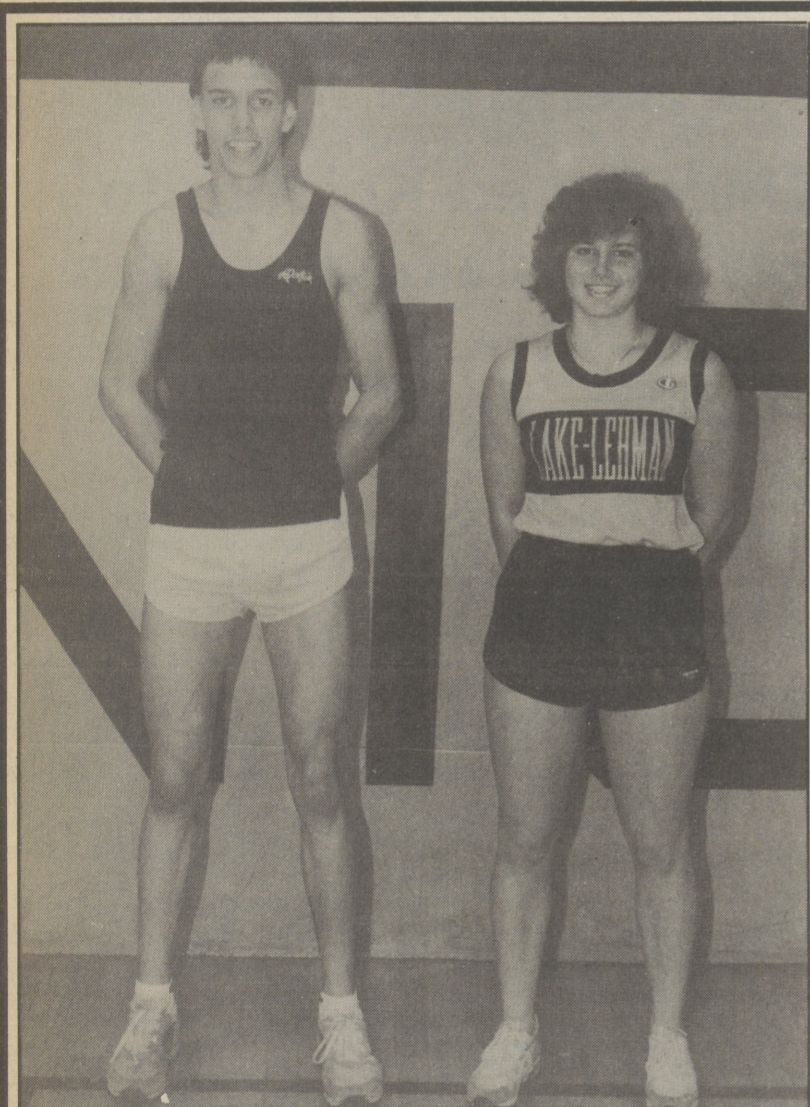
## Denison House opens for new season

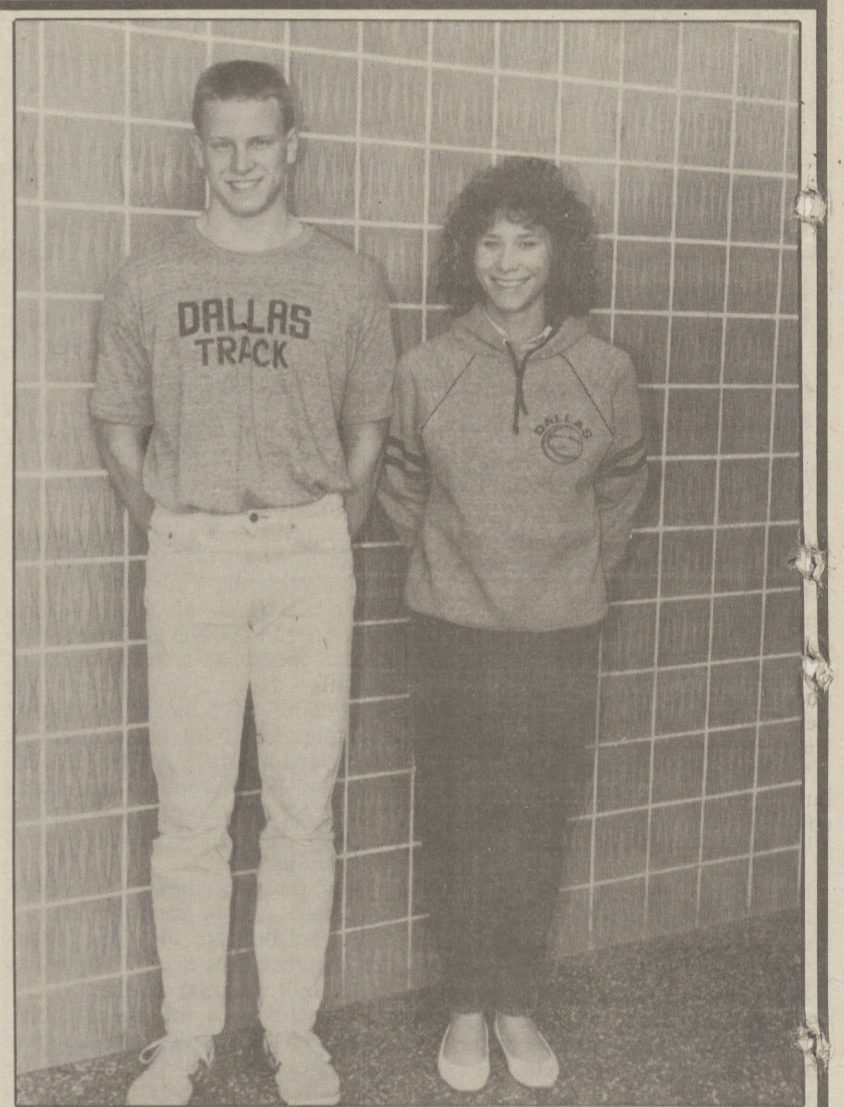
Special events planned for the
