Seniors program available at Catholic Youth Center

The Wyoming Valley Catholic Youth Center announces the 1988 Summer Senior Citizen Action Program will begin Monday, June 20 and go until Friday, Aug. 26. All classes are free of charge to anyone with a CYC Senior Citizen Membership. Classes include Exercise in Water, Monday, Wednesday and Friday, 11:30 - 12:30; Exercise on Land, Monday, Tuesday and Thursday, 8 - 9; Swim Lessons, Monday and Wednesday, 2:30 - 3:30; Senior Swim, Monday 8:30 - 10:30 and 2:30 - 4; Tuesday, 9:30 - 10:30 and 2:30 - 4; Wednesday, 8:30 - 10:30 and 2:30 - 4; Seniors may also take advantage of the Membership Activities such as Lunch Hour Swim Monday through Friday, 11:30 - 12:30, or Tennis during any scheduled open hours, Open Gym during any scheduled open hours, and for men the use of the Health Center Monday through Friday 9 - 4. Tennis lessons will be given when requested.

Senior Swim is purely recreational. Swimming includes lap swim, exercising, floating or just plain socialization and cooling off. The swim lessons allow participant to work on whatever they wish. Lessons are individual progressions, it is not a group designed class. If you miss a day or week you can pick up where you left off.

The CYC has two tennis courts and a handball wall. If you wish to come by yourself you can practice against the wall or pick up a game with our resident Tennis Pro John Benz. Tennis racquet and ball are available upon request.

Also this year we will be continuing our S.I.S.S.L.E. Club. The Senior Swim and Lap Elite Club is for anyone who can swim 40 laps or more during the summer. These seniors become honorary members of the club and have their names added to the Elite Roll Call.

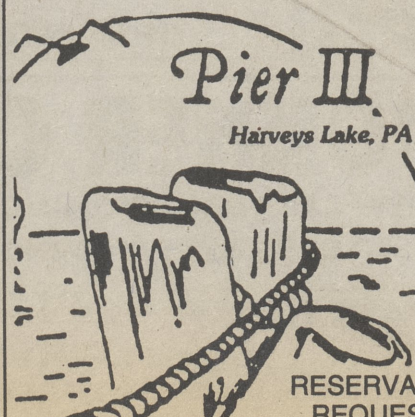
