Sr. Finley to get Sister of Mercy award

Sr. M. Siena Finley, RSM, will be the first recipient of College Misericordia's Sister of Mercy Award. The award will be presented to the Dallas resident on Saturday, Oct. 1, during the college's Homecoming activities.

Sr. Siena has been a faculty member at College Misericordia for the past 15 years, however her involvement in the field of education spans four decades. After years of lecturing and making public appearances, Sr. Siena has developed a reputation as one of the top ethicists of the Mid-Atlantic region.

In 1987, Sr. Siena was instrumental in developing the first ethics institute in the area. The Ethics Institute of Northeast Pennsylvania was established to increase understanding of contemporary ethical issues in business, education, government, politics, health care and social services. Through lectureworkshop series, conferences, an ethical resource center and continuing education programs the institute provides a non-partisan forum to exchange ideas and explore major ethical issues in society.

A 1951 alumna of College Misericordia, Sr. Siena also holds a masters degree from Fordham University. She has pursued courses in ethics at Dartmouth, Princeton and Catholic University. Last year, she was awarded the Humanitarian of the Year Award by the Wyoming Valley Interfaith Council. Among her board memberships are the board of directors of the Mercy Care Unit and the board of directors of Mercy Hospital.
