Residents are advised to have leaves bagged and placed at the curbside for pick up. The pick up is limited to bagged leaves only. Township crews will be conducting the pick up between the hours of 7 a.m. and 3 p.m., Monday through Fri-

Road Superintendent Chamberlain asks the cooperation of residents in refraining from sweeping leaves into gutters and roadways. The leaves tend to block storm drains and this poses a serious mainte-nance problem to the Road Department. A Township ordinance also prohibits this practice.

Leaf pick up will proceed as weather permits and snow removal will supersede all other maintenance
