The Fund shall be under the direction of the Council of this Borough or such committee or persons as the Council of this Borough may from time to time designate by resolution, who shall act as Trustees of the Fund, and such Trustees shall have full responsibility for the administration of the program established hereunder and shall hold, invest, reinvest and distribute all funds or other property received pursuant hereto in trust for the purposes of this ordinance. The Trustees may receive at any time and from time to time gifts, grants, devises or bequests to the Fund of any money or prop-erty, real, personal or mixed, to be held by them in trust for the benefit of the Fund in accordance with the provisions hereof.
