Dallas Senior High student wins award

Dallas Senior High School received its third consecutive National Achievement Award for superior art work in the 61st National High School Art Exhibition presented by Scholastic Inc. This year's exhibition was viewed at the Cleveland Institute of Art, Cleveland, Ohio, from June 24 to July 13.

Donald Burke, a 1988 Dallas High School graduate, was the Hallmark Honor Prize winner of \$100.00 cash award for the past school year. He is presently attending the Savannah College of Art and Design on a \$15,000 scholarship for Art (architectural design).

The national co-sponsors of this award are the Eastman Kodak Co., Hallmark Cards (Photography), Hallmark Cards Inc. (Art), National Broadcasting Co. (Writing), and Strathmore Paper Co. (Art). Approximately 200,000 entries were submitted to 65 regional sponsors from schools in their area. From those entries, more than 450 National Award winning works were included in the exhibition. Panels of distinguished artists and educators carefully surveyed the finalists to determine winners in various categories.

Marine Private Charles Leaf recently graduated from the Marine Corps Recruit Depot, Parris Island, S.C.

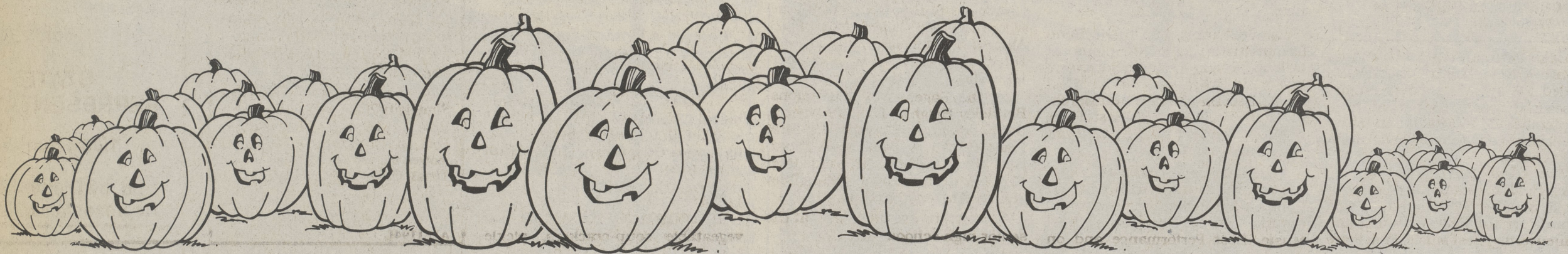


