### 100 PBS video tapes now available

The Back Mountain Memorial Library has received 100 videocassette tapes through the Public Broadcasting Service at a discounted price. These videotapes will be paid for by the library during a four year period with funds committed for this purpose. A portion of the cost of these videotapes is being funded through participation with an LSCA Title I fund project. The library has received a basic collection of 80 titles chosen from the PBS Video current catalog. We were also able to choose 20 unique titles for our own particular collection. At the present time, 40 of these videos are on the shelves and able to be borrowed by the public, for a one week period. Some of the titles of the videos are: American State Play Specials, "Heartbreak House" and "The Dining Room"; Here's to your Health videos, "Oh, My Aching Back" and "Exercise: Shaping Up";

Spaceflight, "Thunder in the Skies" and "The Wings of Mercury"; America's Civil Rights Years, "Awakenings" (1954-56) and "Eyes on the Prize" Fighting Back (1957-62). Some Mister Rogers videos: "Death of a Goldfish" and "Mister Rogers Talks with Parents About Competition"; Leo Buscaglia, "All the Special Children" and "Loving Relationships" and Frontline videos, "What About Mom and Dad?"; "Stopping Drugs" and "Inside the Jury Room".
