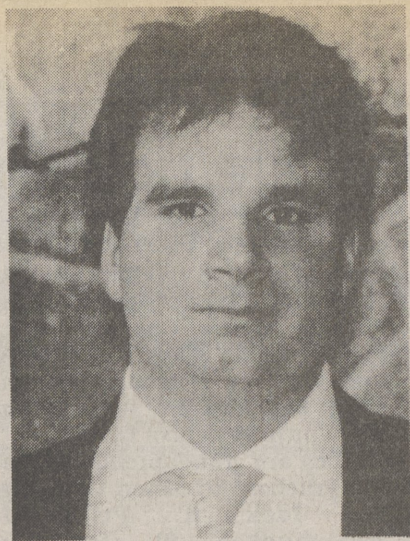


Kasper in Harveys Lake council race

Joseph 'Red' Jones seeks re-election to school board

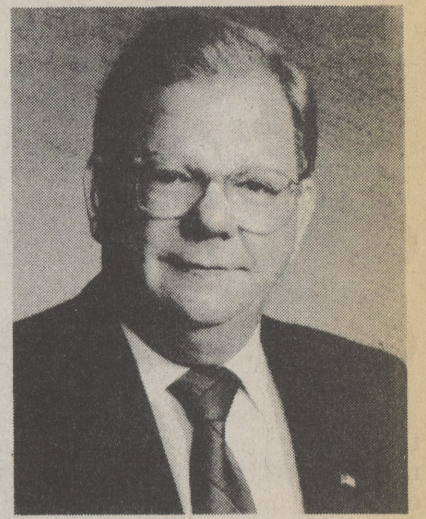
