N. Roberts of Nanticoke was honored for 10 years of service to the VNA Board.

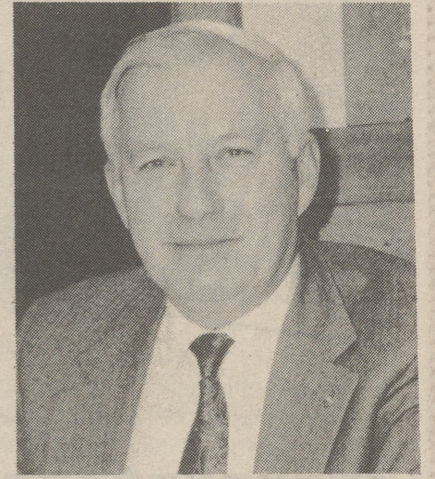

All participants of previous races will be receiving registration applications and sponsor pledge forms in the mail. New participants are encouraged to join in any or all of the 25 mile scenic ride through the Back Mountain. The ride will begin at the Dallas Senior High School at 9 a.m. For every \$5 of pledges a participant turns into the American Cancer Society, on the day of the ride, he/she will receive a ticket.
