### Children's event planned for June

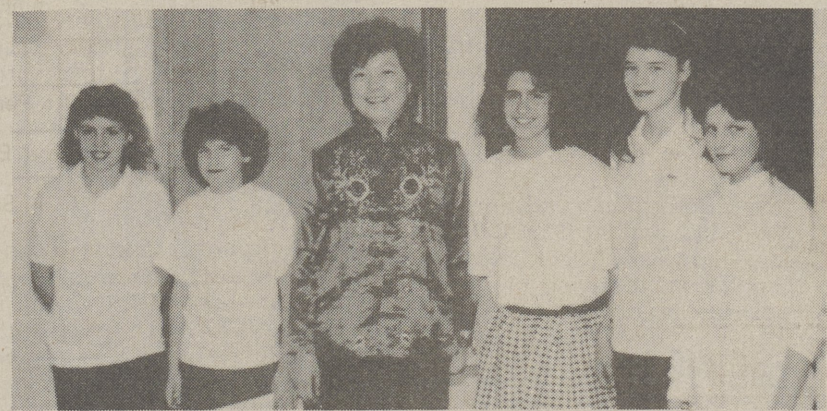
