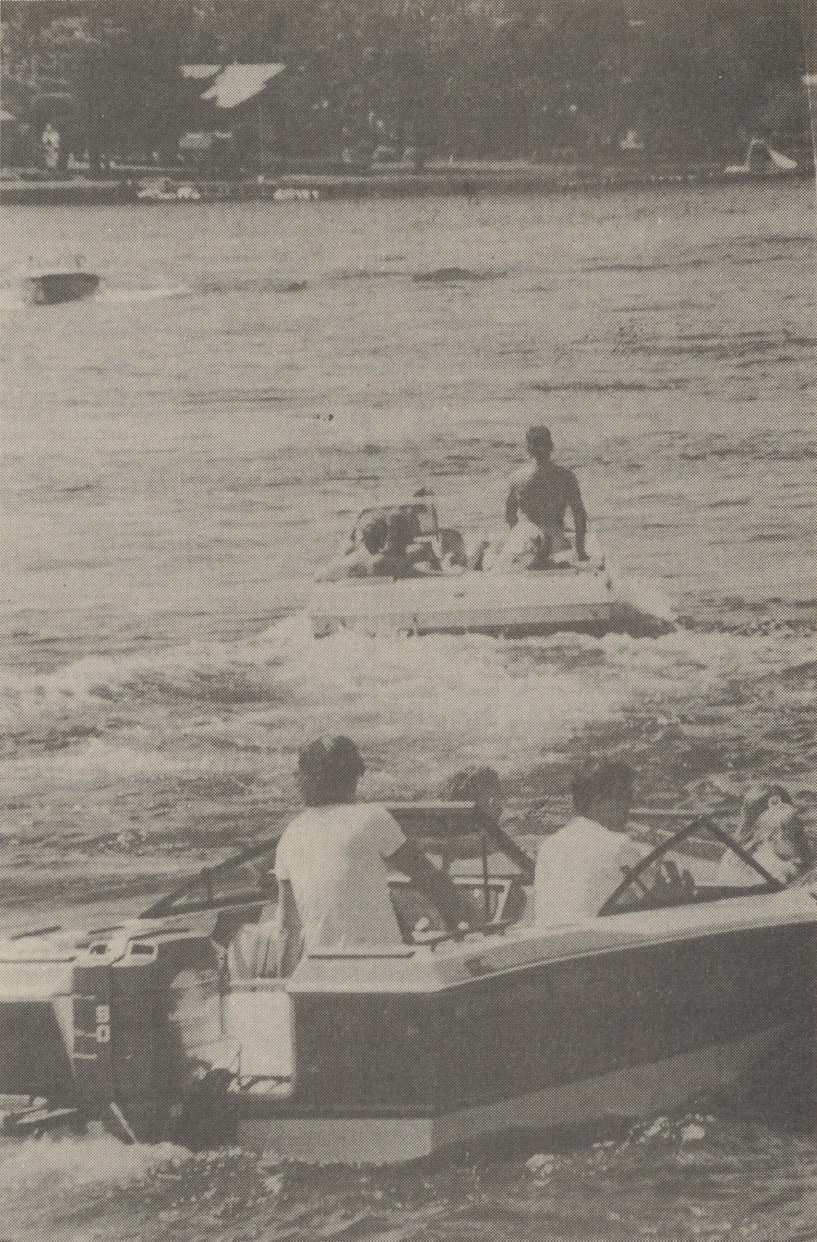
Just For Kids

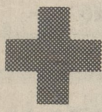
