retaries of the district were also increased by six percent for the 1989-1990 school year with the exception of Margery Stephenson, whose salary increase was eight percent. Their salaries were listed as follows: Anne Morgan, payroll clerk \$19,214.66; Alice Spencer, assistant business manager \$23,582.12; Margery Stephenson, secretary to the business manager \$13,389.76; Chris Cimakosky, bookkeeper, \$15,547.07 and Carol Pierson, secretary to the superintendent, \$17,490.

The board also approved a motion to transfer Mrs. Linda Burd, nurse, from a 3/4 time professional employee to a full time professional employee, to replace Mrs. Thomas at the Westmoreland and Dallas Elementary Schools at an annual salary of \$19,170.

Mrs. Debra Hadzor was given a regular tenure contract as guidance counselor in the elementary schools and Michael Pawlik was contracted as a music teacher for the Middle School.

The resignation of Mrs. Nancy Miller as secretary to the athletic

director was accepted with regret. The board also approved a motion to submit an application for federal funds under the education consolidation and improvement act of 1981 and further approved the school district to serve as the sponsoring agency to operate the programs according to the act.

A second motion was approved by the board to submit an application for a Drug Free Schools grant in the amount of \$9,258.

The collective bargaining agreement between the Dallas School District and Dallas School Service Personnel Association on July 9, 1989, was ratified by the Dallas directors in the specific form as presented to the Dallas School Service Personnel Association. These negotiations had been bargaining for the past year before settlement was made.

In other business the Dallas School Board approved partial payment to the Ruth Corporation for plumbing at the Dallas Elementary project and for heating, air conditioning and ventilation at

the same school; partial payment to Rogan Electric for electrical work; partial payment to Interco Construction for work at the Dallas Elementary School and partial payment to Smith, Miller & Associates Inc. for services at the senior high school.

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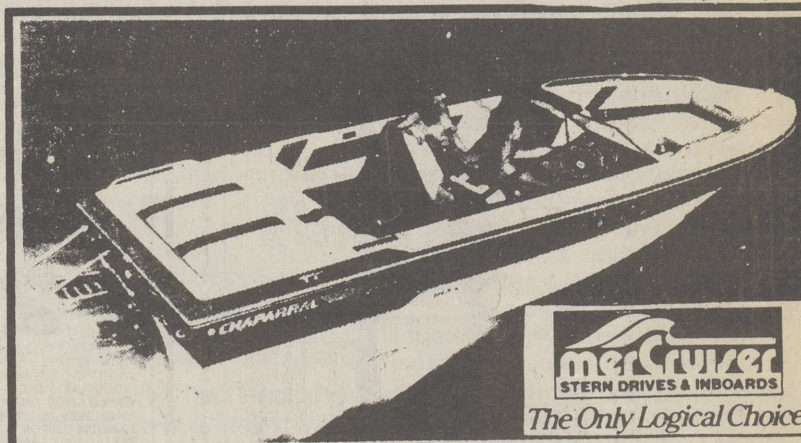
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
