'Simply Elegant' Irem Ball slated for July 22

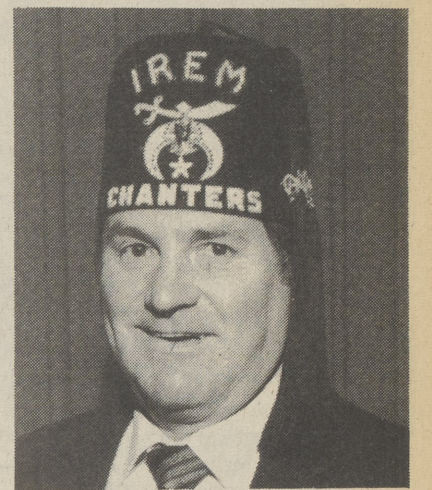
