

## Dallas youths to compete in Keystone Games

Susan Richardson, Megan Moran and Jessica Wallace of Dallas will be among the 6,000 Pennsylvania amateur athletes to compete in the 1989 Keystone State Summer Games finals scheduled for August 9-13, in the Wilkes-Barre/Scranton area. Richardson, Moran and Wallace have entered the Soccer competition, Junior Scholastic Division for the Pocono Region. Richardson also competed in the Keystone Games Junior Scholastic Soccer in 1988.

Richardson, Moran and Wallace are freshmen students at Dallas Area High School. They are the daughters of Bob and Sandy Richardson, Ron and Elaine Moran and Brad and Lois Noble.

Rick Javer of Dallas will compete in the 1989 Keystone State Games Finals. Javer has entered the Ice Hockey Competition Midget Division for the Pocono/Blue Mountain/Capitol Region representing 26 counties. The Midgets are 15 and 16 year olds, Javer is 14 years old.
