Watercolor artist Leigh Pawling, a native of Dallas, will exhibit her paintings during the month of August in the lobby of the United Penn Bank, Main Street, Dallas.

Ms. Pawling, a graduate of Dallas High School, has been painting for over 13 years. She exhibits her work regularly, and has been commissioned by a gallery in the Grand Cayman Islands to produce a series of watercolor florals for sale in their Gallery. She has stud-

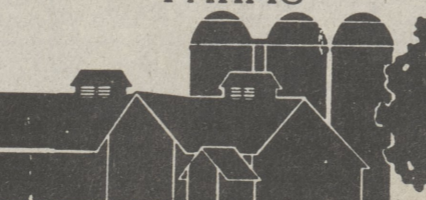
